When you first log into Powerschool you will get an overview of the students total grades for each class

In order to see WHY a student has a particular grade you will need to click on that grade

When you click on the grade it will pull up a report of all the graded assignments for that class and quarter

What do the colors and symbols mean in Powerschool?

If an assignment is Missing (the student has not completed or turned in the assignment) the teacher will mark it with an **orange** missing symbol

Missing assignments are marked so that parents and students know what needs to be completed in order to increase their grade.

Blue stands for incomplete and most teachers use this to mark assignments that were turned in but could be retaken for a better grade (like a major grade)

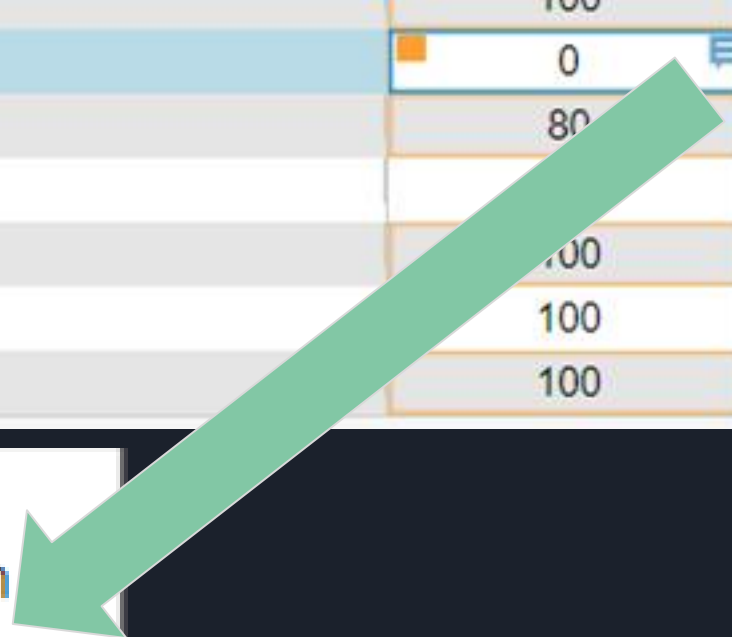

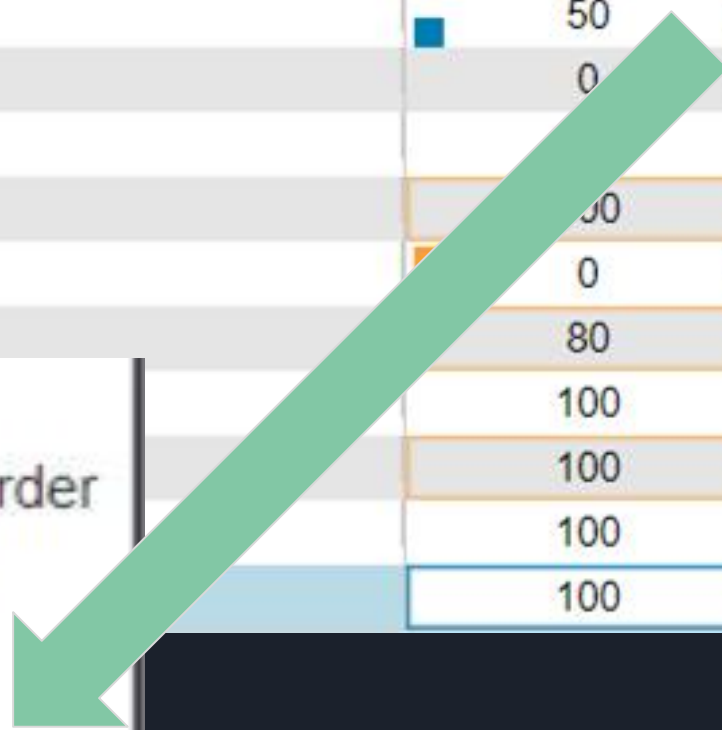

Why are students asked to email the teacher when a missing assignment has been completed?
